

Crew Hours and Concert Attendance Requirements for 2015-16

Crew Hours

All students must work 6 or more crew hours per year. The process for documenting will be:

- 1) An index card will be kept on file in the Band Hall (room 273) for each student. Each grade level(s) will have their own designated box in which to keep the cards.
- 2) Within 48 hours of the completion of a crew session, the student will take his/her card out of the filing box; bring written documentation signed by the supervising music teacher to Mr. Schnitzer, who will punch the card with the appropriate number of punches.
- 3) A grade for the completed crew card will be documented in the student's primary ensemble at the conclusion of the 5th six weeks of the school year.
- 4) Senior students who wish to be recognized as High Honors or Honors Graduates must successfully complete their hours to be considered.

Concert Attendance

All Music Students must attend one concert/performance/exhibit from each cluster other than their own during the school year. The process for documenting will be:

- 1) PEAR Cards will be issued to each student at the beginning of the school year. It is up to the student to keep up with his or her own PEAR Card throughout the school year. It is recommended that students keep a picture of their card in their cell phone as a backup for documentation purposes.
- 2) When a student has attended a cluster event, a representative from that cluster will punch the card using their designated cluster punch.
- 3) A grade for a completed PEAR card will be documented in the student's primary ensemble at the conclusion of the final 6 weeks of the school year.
- 4) Senior students who wish to be recognized as High Honors or Honors Graduates must successfully complete their concert attendance requirement.

MET Live attendance

All Music Students currently enrolled in any level of Music Theory class will be required to attend 2 or more performances of MET Live that will be streamed live into the MAT. Students may substitute a live performance of the Dallas Opera for a MET Live performance. MET Live Opera dates are: October 17, January 30, February 27, and April 2. A completion grade will be entered at the conclusion of the final 6 weeks of the school year in their Music Theory class.
